How to create your account:

- Go to Clark's website (clark.cusd.com)
- Click on "library"
- Click on "online catalog"
- Click on "create account" in the upper right corner
 - o Follow the directions:
 - o Enter your last name
 - Barcode (entire student ID)
 - Your birthdate (use the drop down menu)
- You'll be asked to create a user name and password.
 - User Name: Use your Google docs user name (firstinitiallastnamelast3 digits)
 - o Password: Your entire student ID

Now, you have your own Destiny Quest account. You are able to place books on hold, create lists of books, and write reviews of books you've read.

How to write a book review:

- 1. Read a book from our library
- 2. Login to your Destiny Quest account
- 3. Search by title to find the book in our online catalog
- 4. Click on the "Reviews" tab
- 5. Click on "add a review"
- 6. Rate the book using the star icons
- 7. Then, write a review that would help other Clark students decide whether or not they want to read this book. Remember, this review will be sent to Mrs. Lamb for approval before it is published, so keep your review appropriate for all readers. Use your best spelling and punctuation since this review will be on the Internet for everyone to see.
 - Here are some examples of reviews written by Clark students:
- Lightning Thief: The Lightning Thief is an exciting Greek Mythology book with a modern twist. I thought it was quite good!
- **Twilight:** The mystery and unpredictability of their romance keeps you hooked. Stephenie Meyer does such a great job of illustrating the characters, you feel as though you're reading someone's diary instead of a story. The intensity of the feelings Bella feels are super personal, and I thoroughly enjoyed the book. Great love story!
- **Diary of a Wimpy Kid, The Last Straw:** if you are in middle school or a dork you can probably relate to this book because Greg is a dork in middle school that gets made fun of
