- Circulation Policy: You can check out 3 library books at a time for 2 weeks at a time.
- You can renew books for an additional 2 weeks by bringing the book into the LMC for scanning.
- Fines for overdue books: 10 cents per day
- Hall passes are required throughout the school day while classes are in session.
- No hall passes are required before school, at break, at lunch, or after school.
- Turn in books any time in our outside book drop.
- Fiction books are organized alphabetically by author's last name. Hardback fiction begins with FIC with first three letters of author's last name on the second line. Paperback fiction begins with PAP.
- Nonfiction books are organized by the Dewey Decimal System. Posters in the library offer a guide to what each number represents. For example, biographies are categorized under "921."
- Destiny Quest is a free online catalog allowing students and staff an easy way to find out what books are available in the library. Patrons can search by author, title, or subject.
- By creating an account on Destiny Quest, students can personalize their Destiny Quest home page, maintain lists of books, and write book reviews that will be posted for all to read (with approval by librarian).
- Students may put books on hold.
- Students may request books to be placed on our "order wish list."
- The library subscribes to *The Fresno Bee* and an array of popular magazine titles.
- The library offers Playaways, the newest form of audiobooks.
